Suzan Köcher's Suprafon seamlessly blend Psychedelia, Dream Pop, Krautrock, Disco, 60s influences, Desert Americana and Cinema Noir elements. Their hypnotic sound has earned them acclaim at festivals such as Reeperbahn Festival, Traumzeit Festival, Orange Blossom Special and Burg Herzberg Festival, as well as coveted appearances at SXSW in Austin, Texas and WDR Rockpalast. This growing recognition was further underlined by winning the Pop NRW Award 2025 in the category "Outstanding Artist". Their third studio album *In These Dying Times* was released in October 2024 on Unique Records. "I started writing songs when I was 14 because I was afraid to talk about things and be rejected. Music was my way of saying what I think," says German-Turkish musician Suzan Köcher—an experience she shares with many, especially other women.
